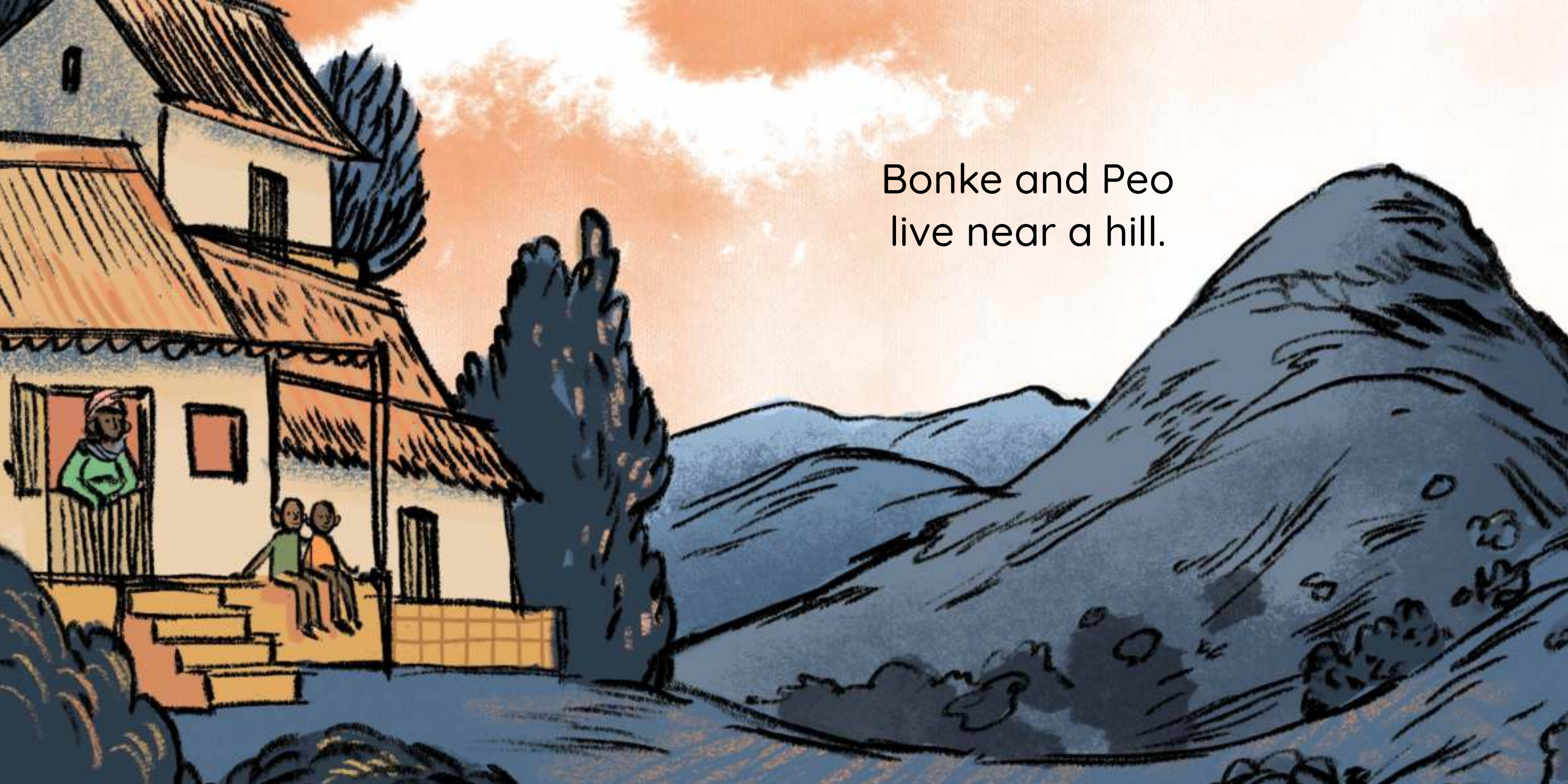

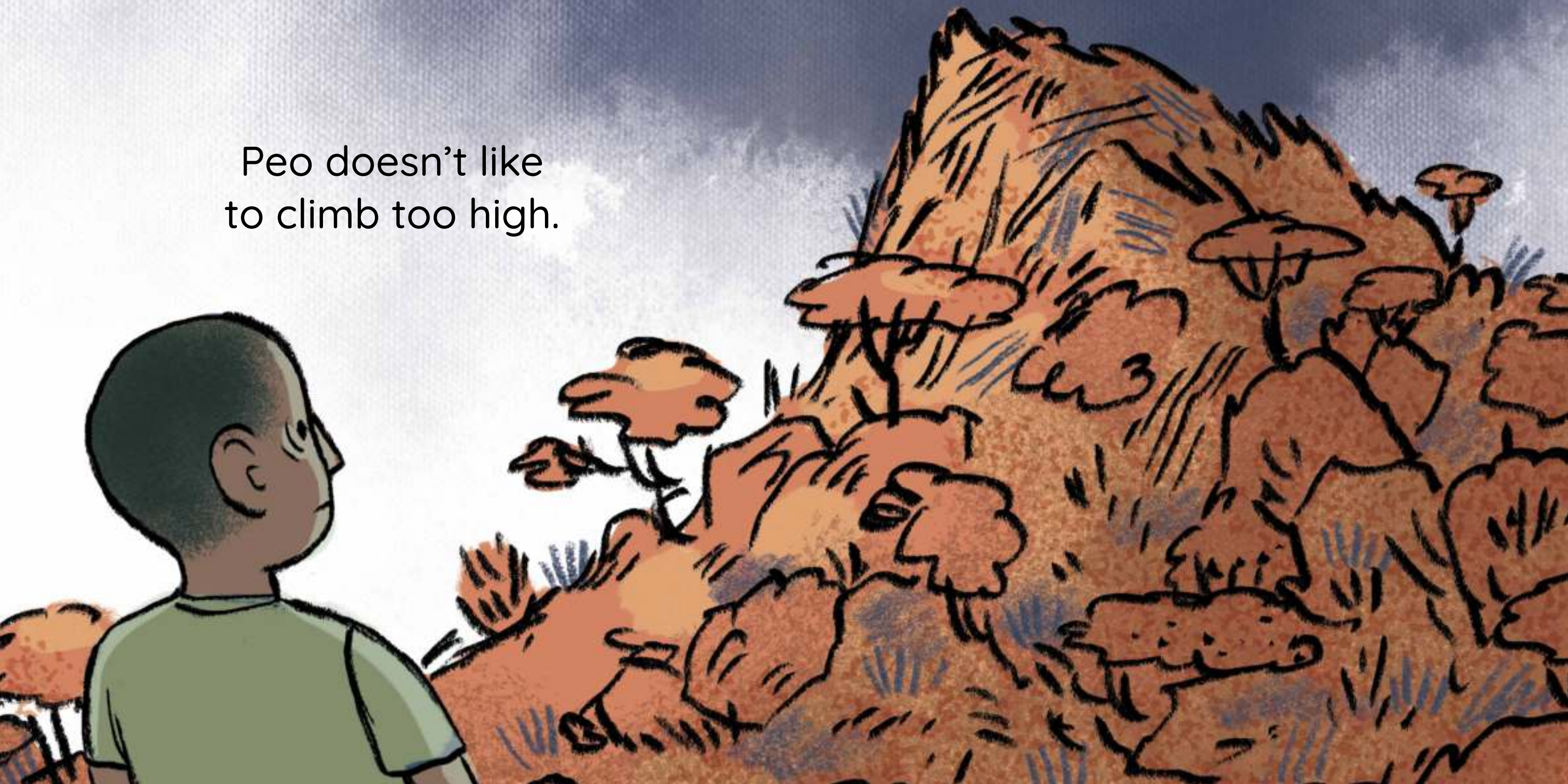
Bonke and Peo

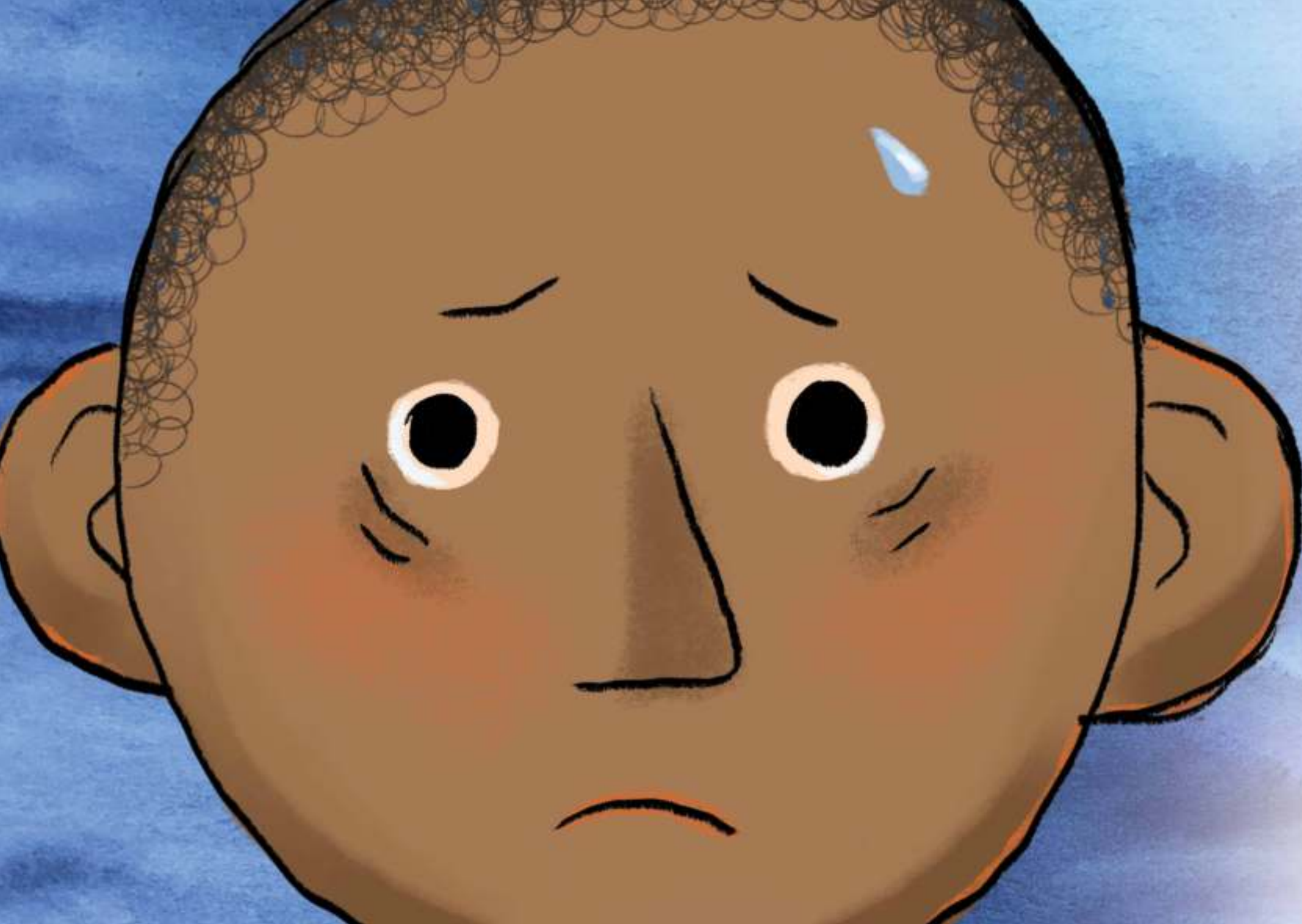
