





- Daddy, hold me




- No, Chi Chi, you're too heavy now. And you can walk by yourself already.




- No no, hold me, my legs hurt. Huhu... I'm crying now!




- Oh, Chi Chi, look, there's some bird flying out of that bush.

- Daddy, I won, I won.




- So tired, let's have a rest.

to, Chi Chi?




- I'll find it our right away, Daddy!
