
“Are you playing with a doll?”

no interest in games.

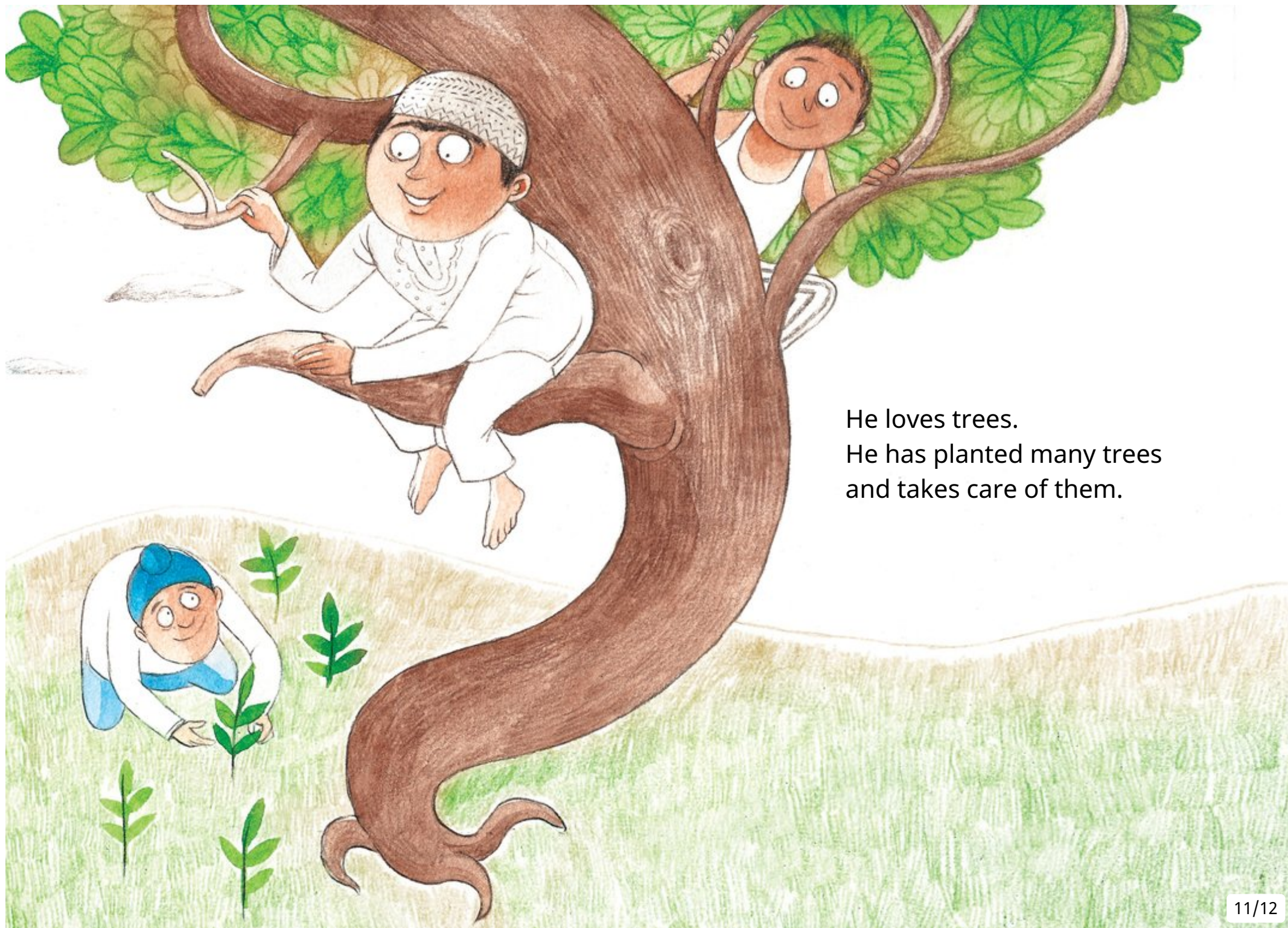


Some love to play
