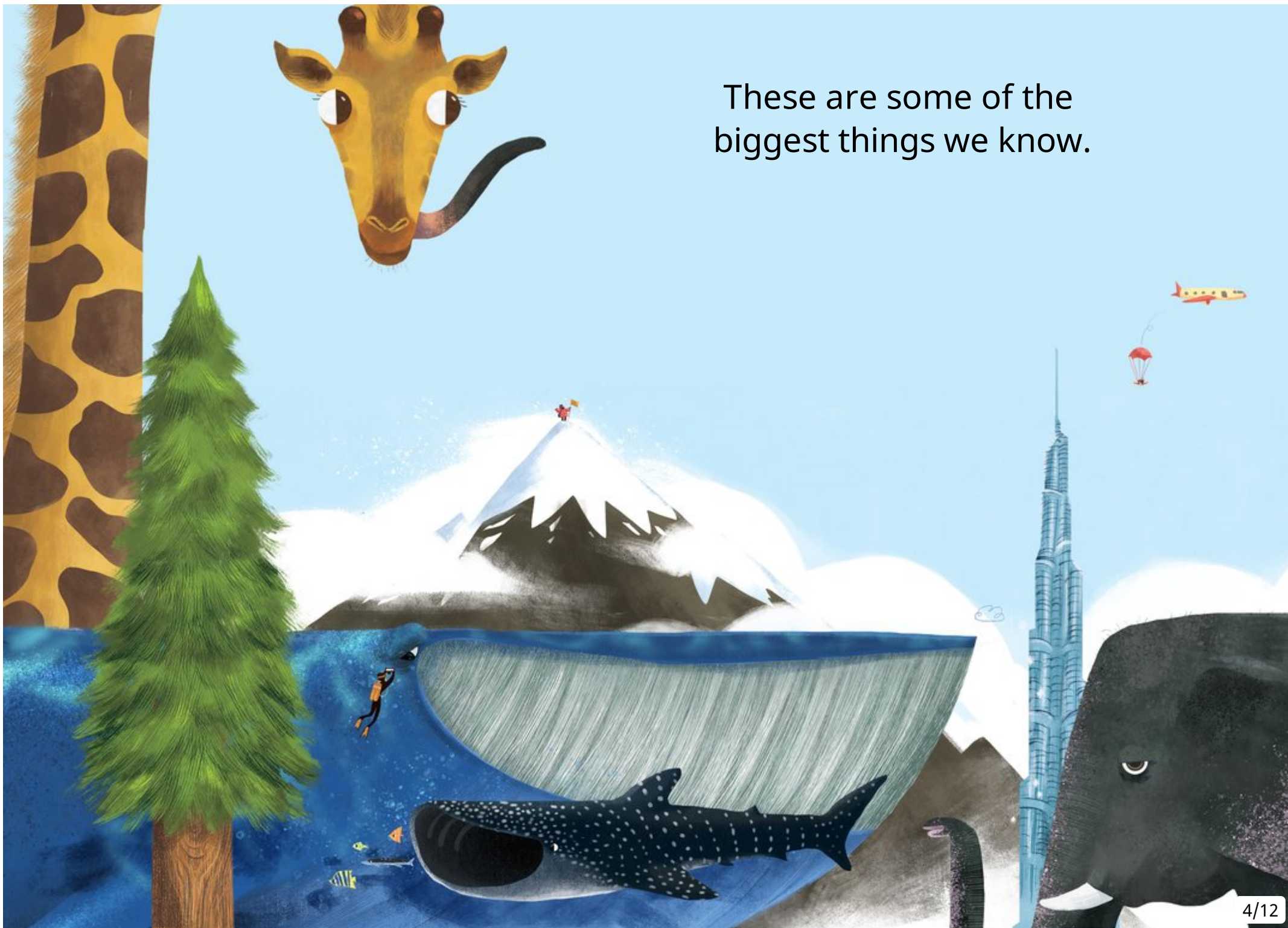

The same things may look small when they're surrounded by bigger things.

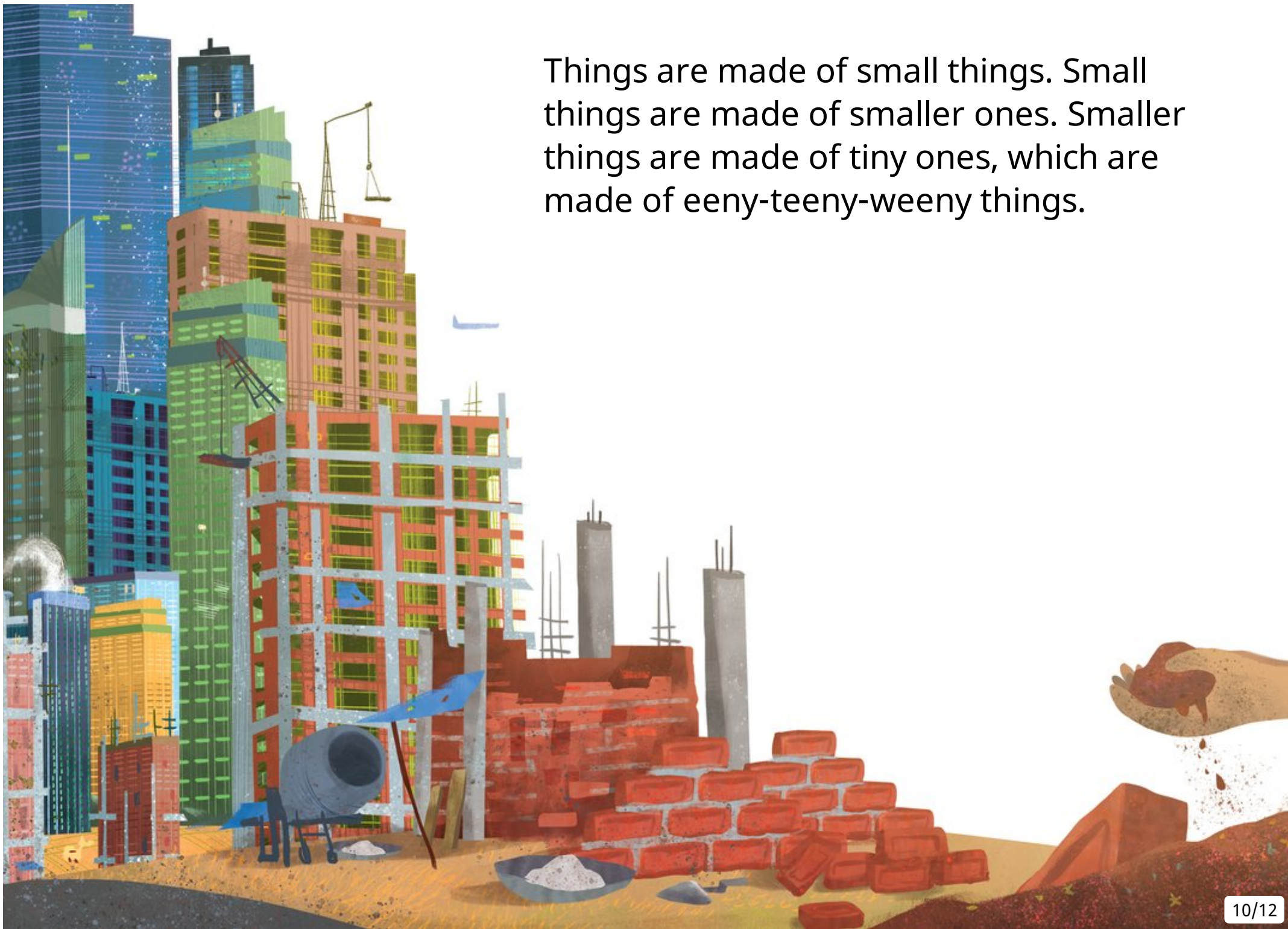
What looks big from close by,
