Honk! Honk! A taxi stops at the corner. Amma is back.


"When did you get a boat?" she asks.

"Because there wasn't enough place for the water in our house," says Tara.




"Why didn't you use buckets to hold the water?" Amma asks.

"It was splashing and washing the floor," adds Tara.







"The pipe! How did it break?" Amma asks.

"CRACK!" says Mini.


"When Baba hit it to get the tap working properly," says Tara.



Amma races into the house, and bursts into the bathroom. The house is ringing with the sound of water rushing and gushing.




Amma opens her toolkit. There are many things in there - a hammer, a wrench, screwdrivers, and a tape.
