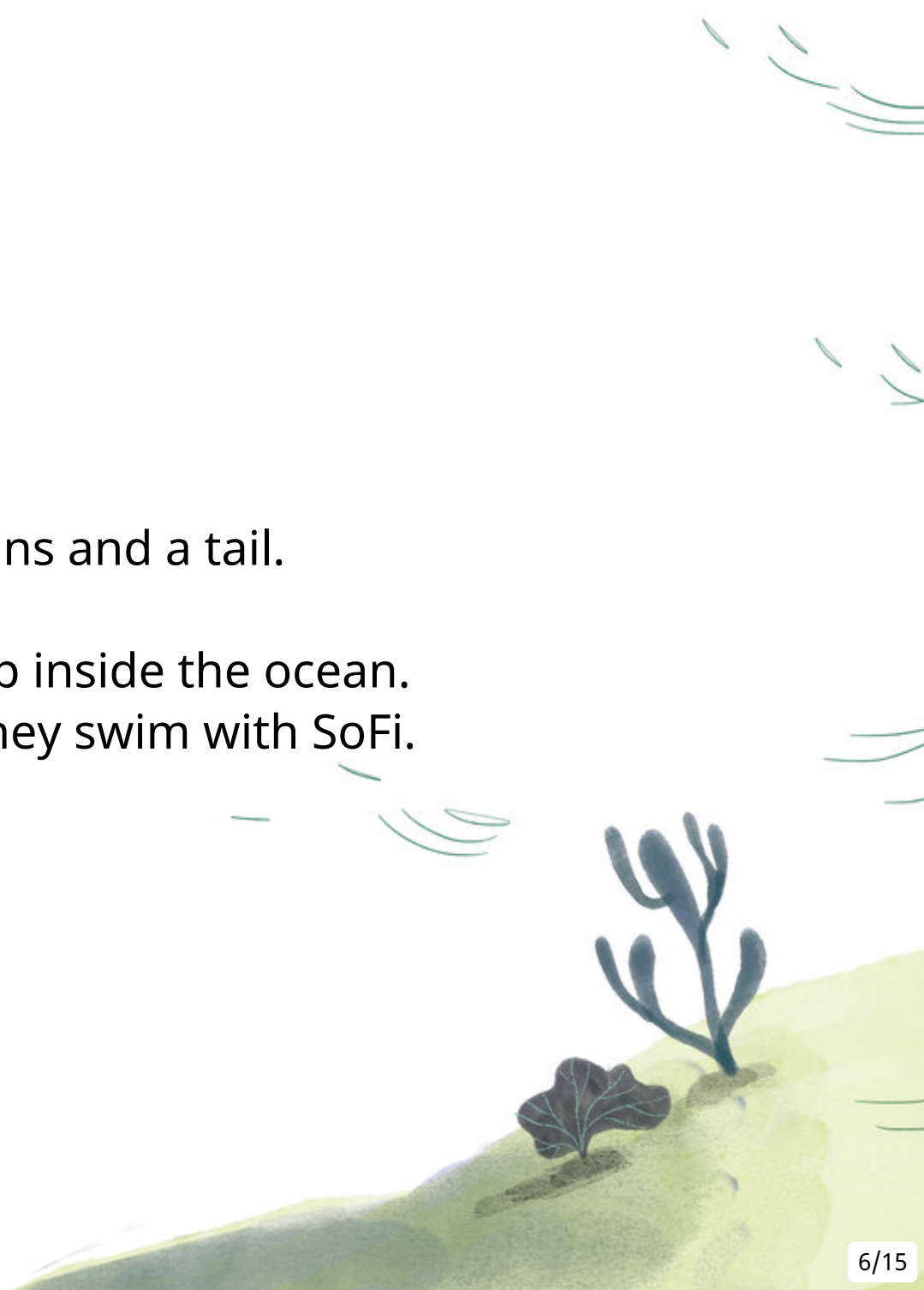

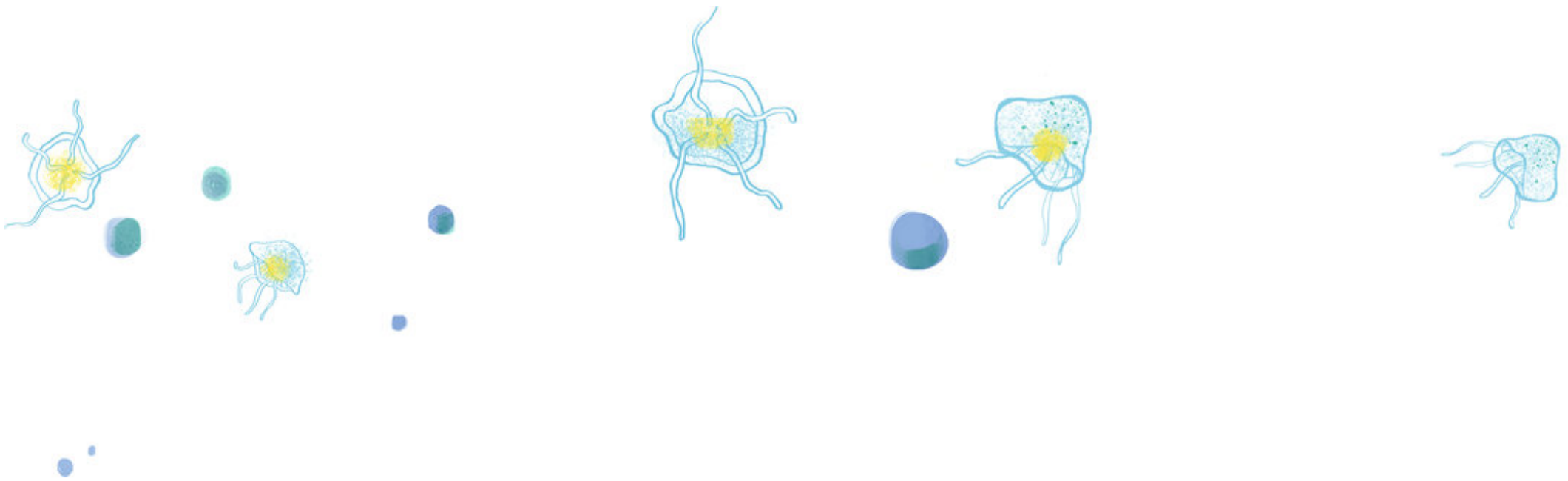


**SoFi** is a soft robot with fins and a tail.

The fish are not afraid. They swim with SoFi.

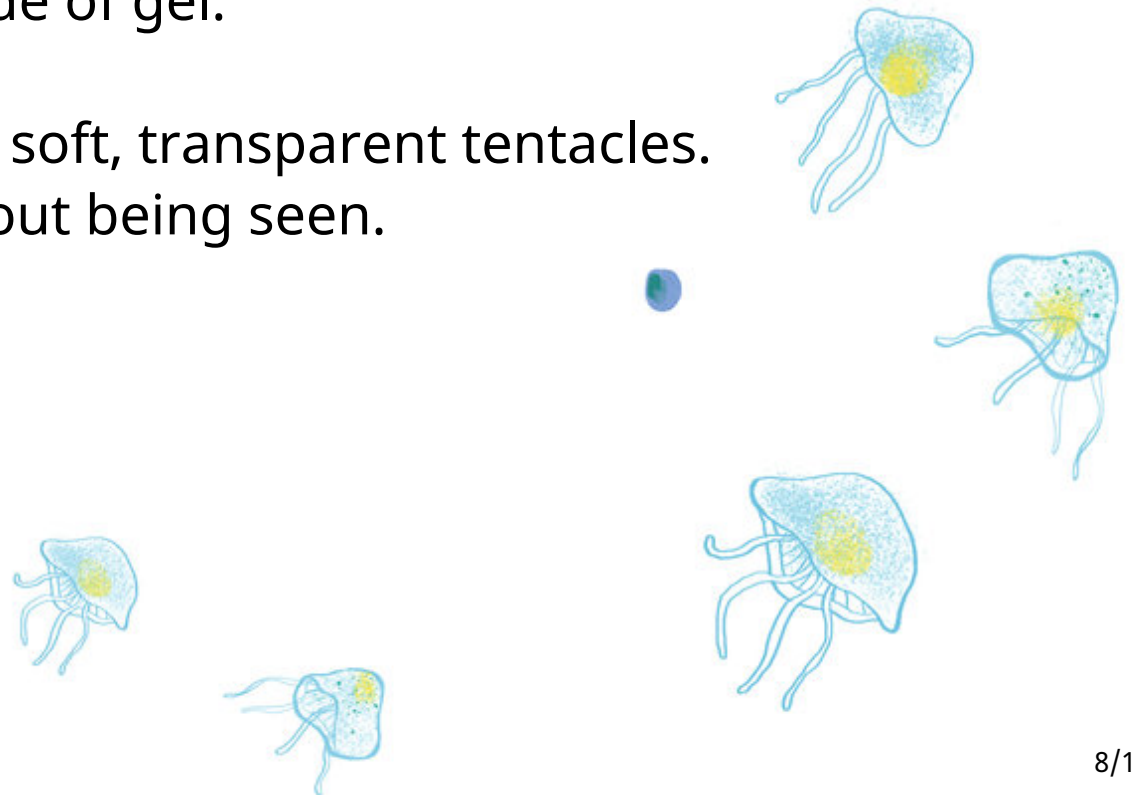




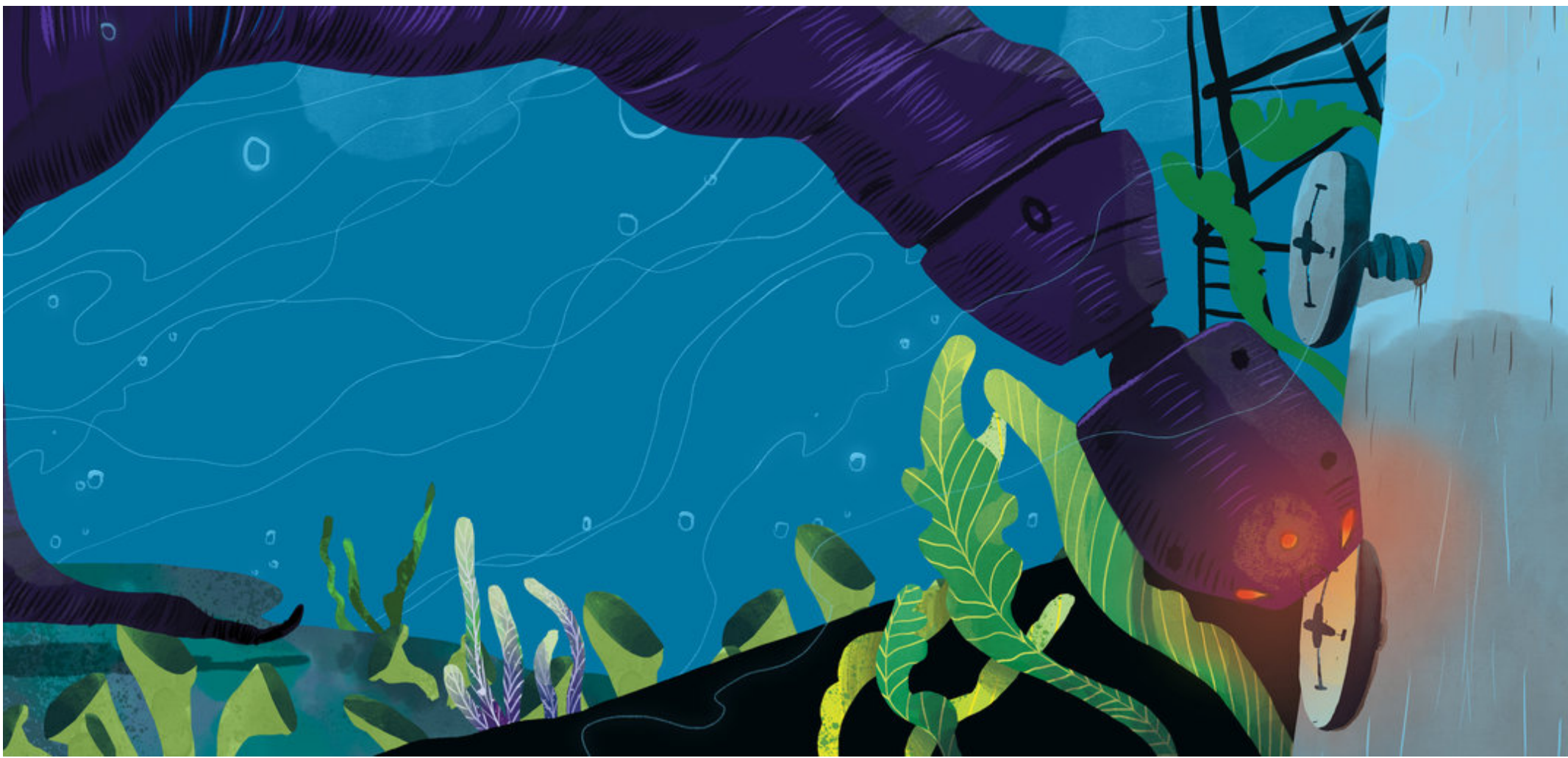


**Jellyfish Robot** is made of gel.

It swims around without being seen.



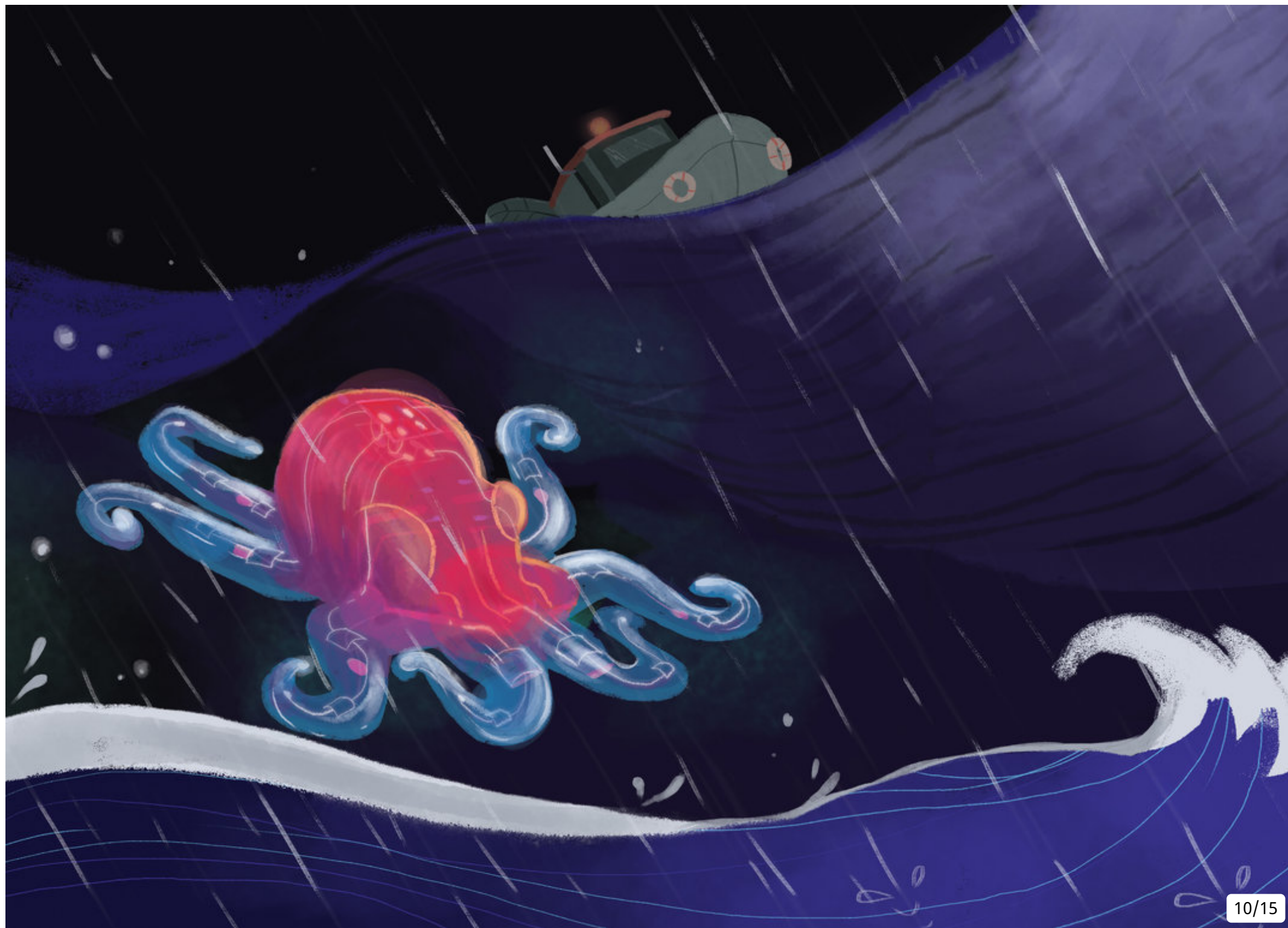




**Robot Eel** has a long, black body and red eyes.

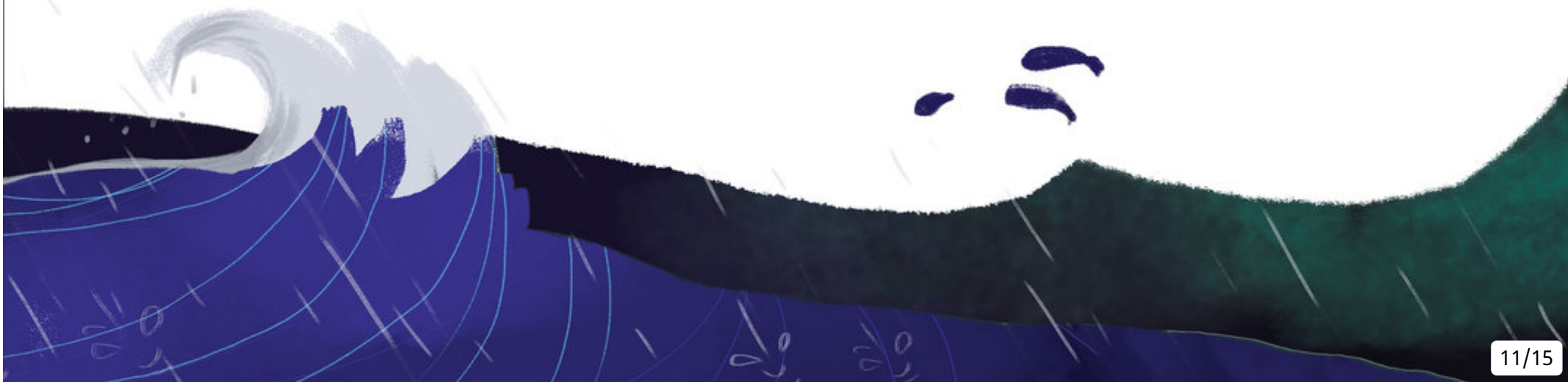
One day, it might live on the sea floor.

It might fix broken pipes and machines underwater.

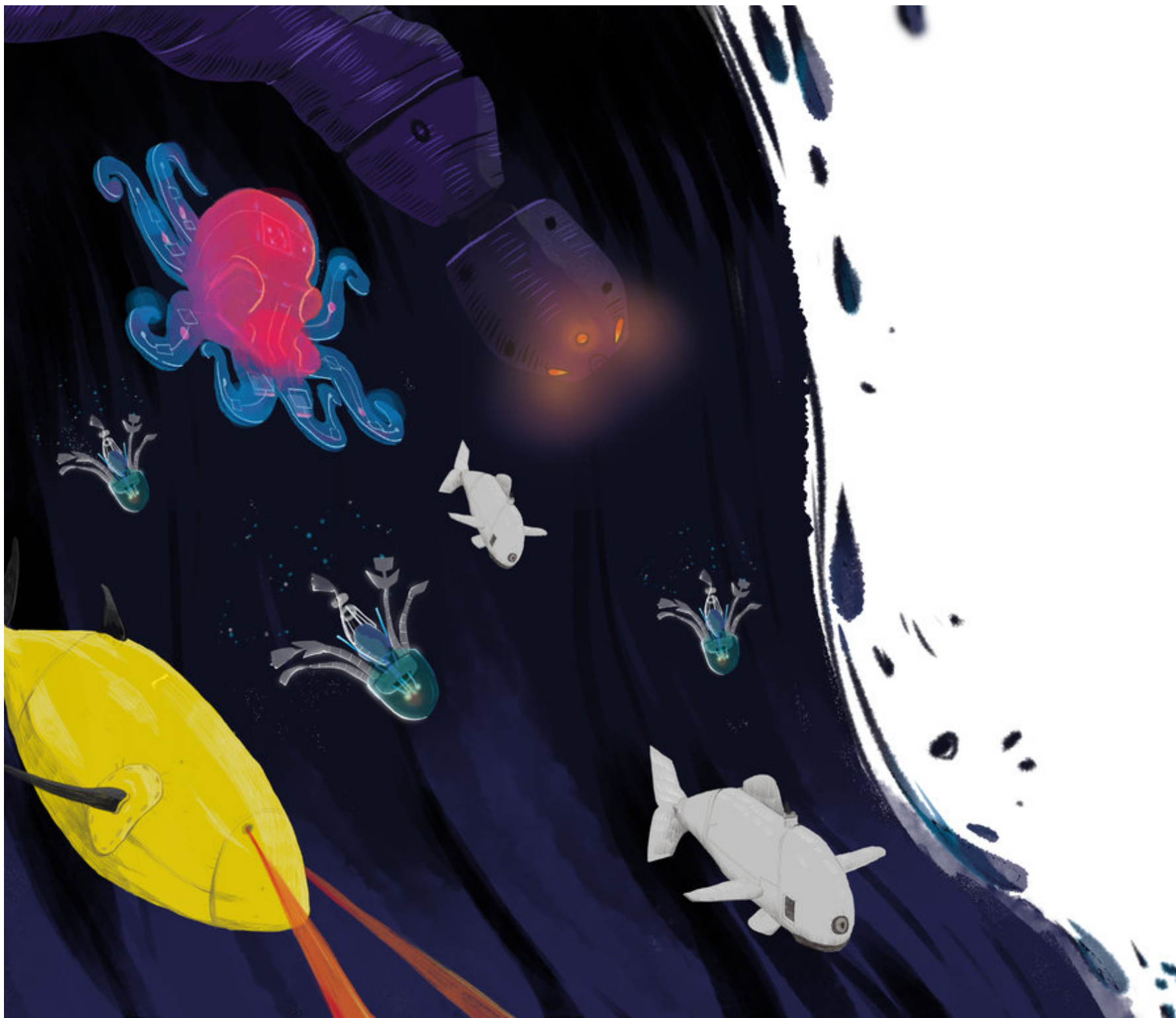


**OctoBot** looks like a small octopus.
