not right.*





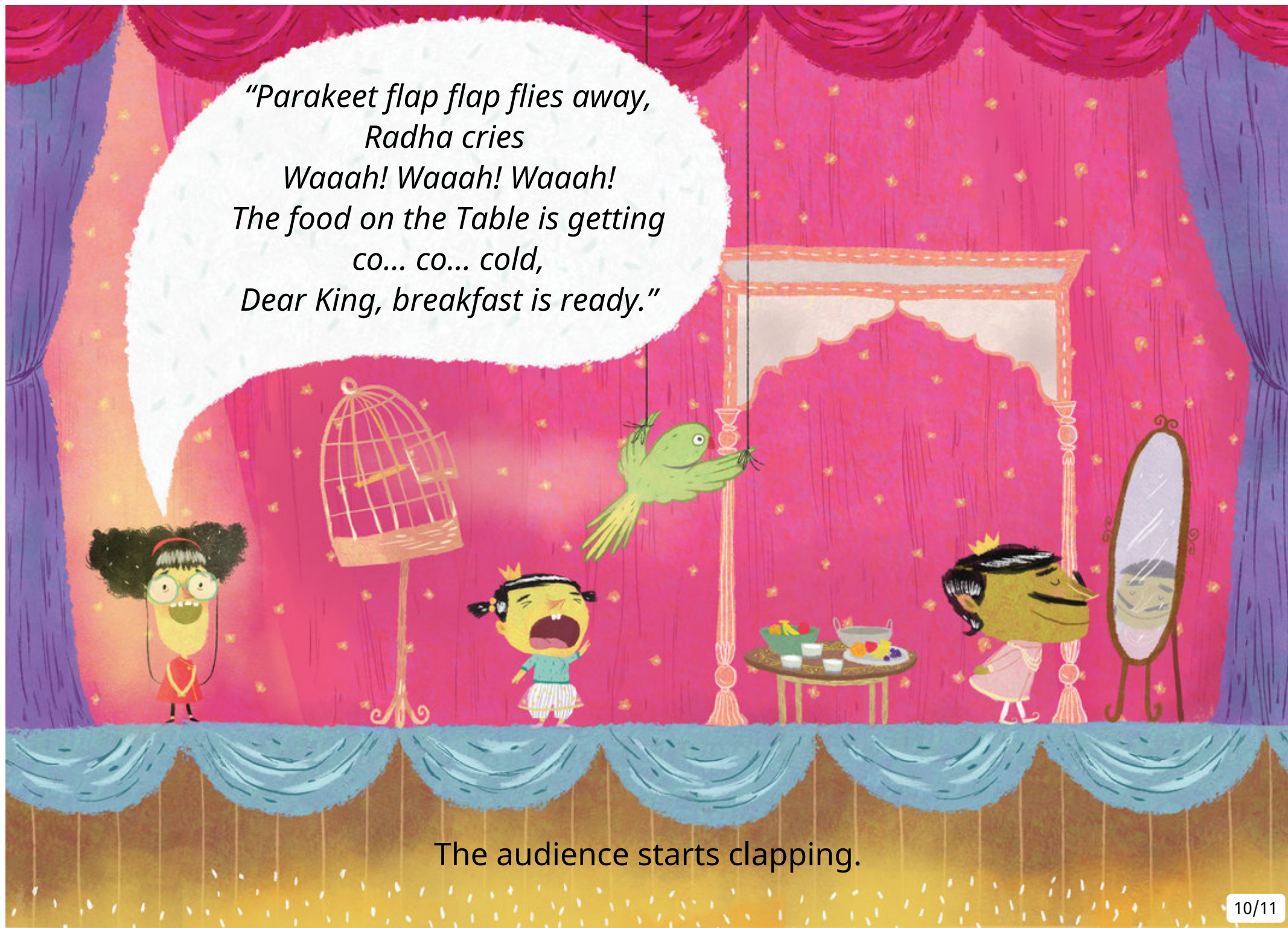


"Ammu, it's your turn," Miss Malati calls out.
