in the fields.

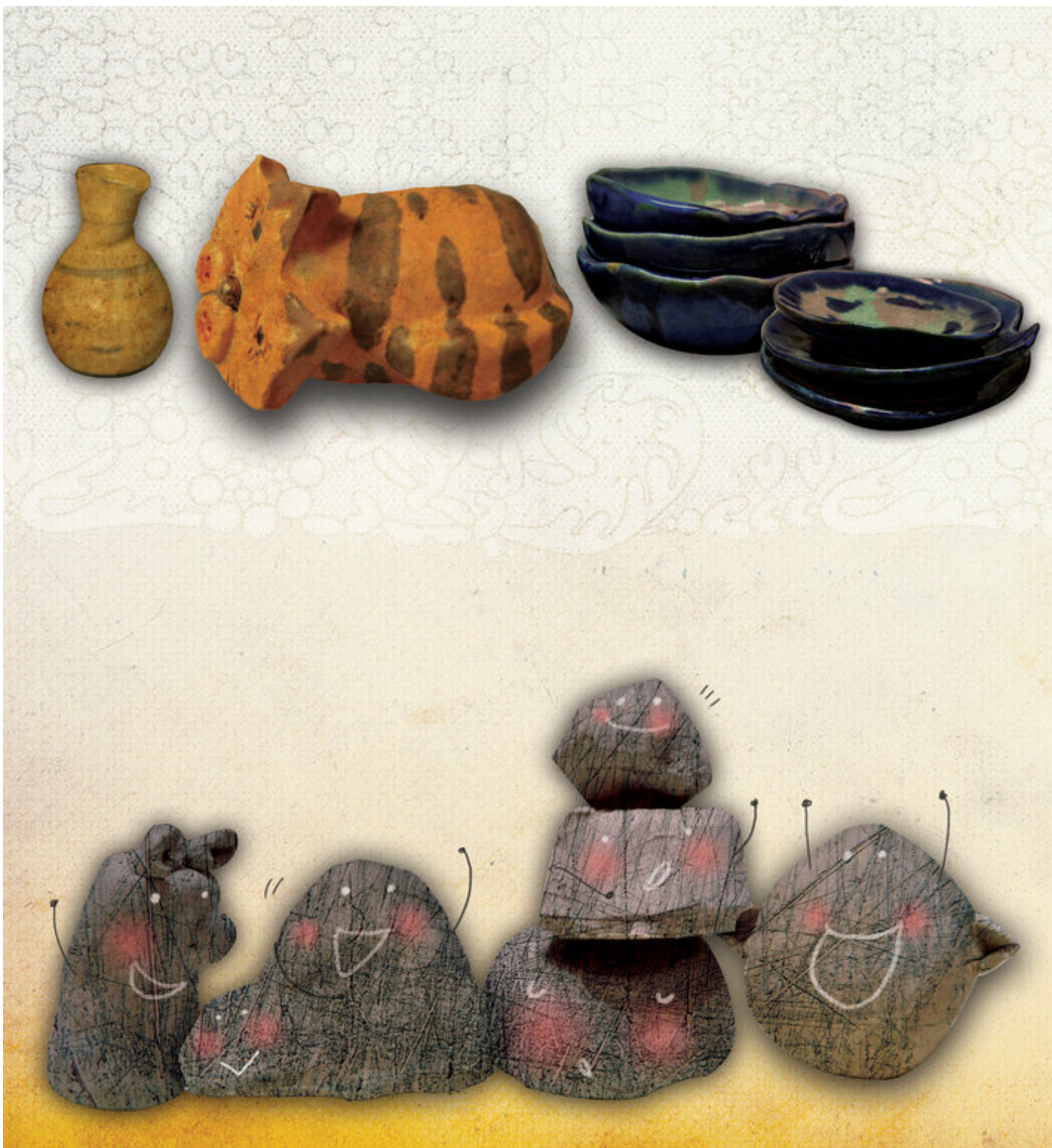




Later that day, they meet Miss Wind.

"That means we will become cups and vases and jugs and jars," said the clay. "Right, Miss Wind?"






"Yes, but also keep in mind," she replied, "that you may face some challenges in the process."

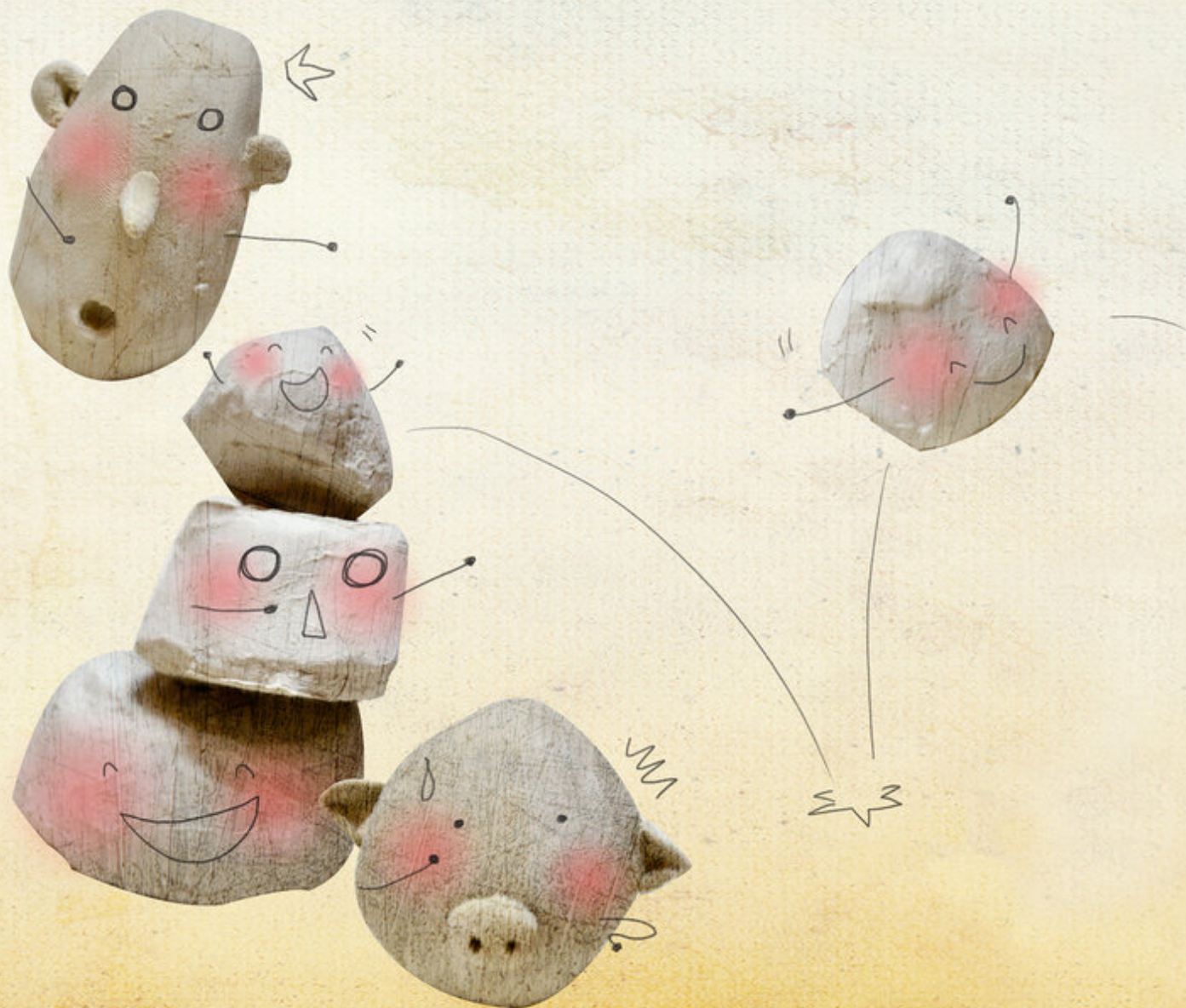
"We are not afraid!" said the lumps of clay. "No fear!"

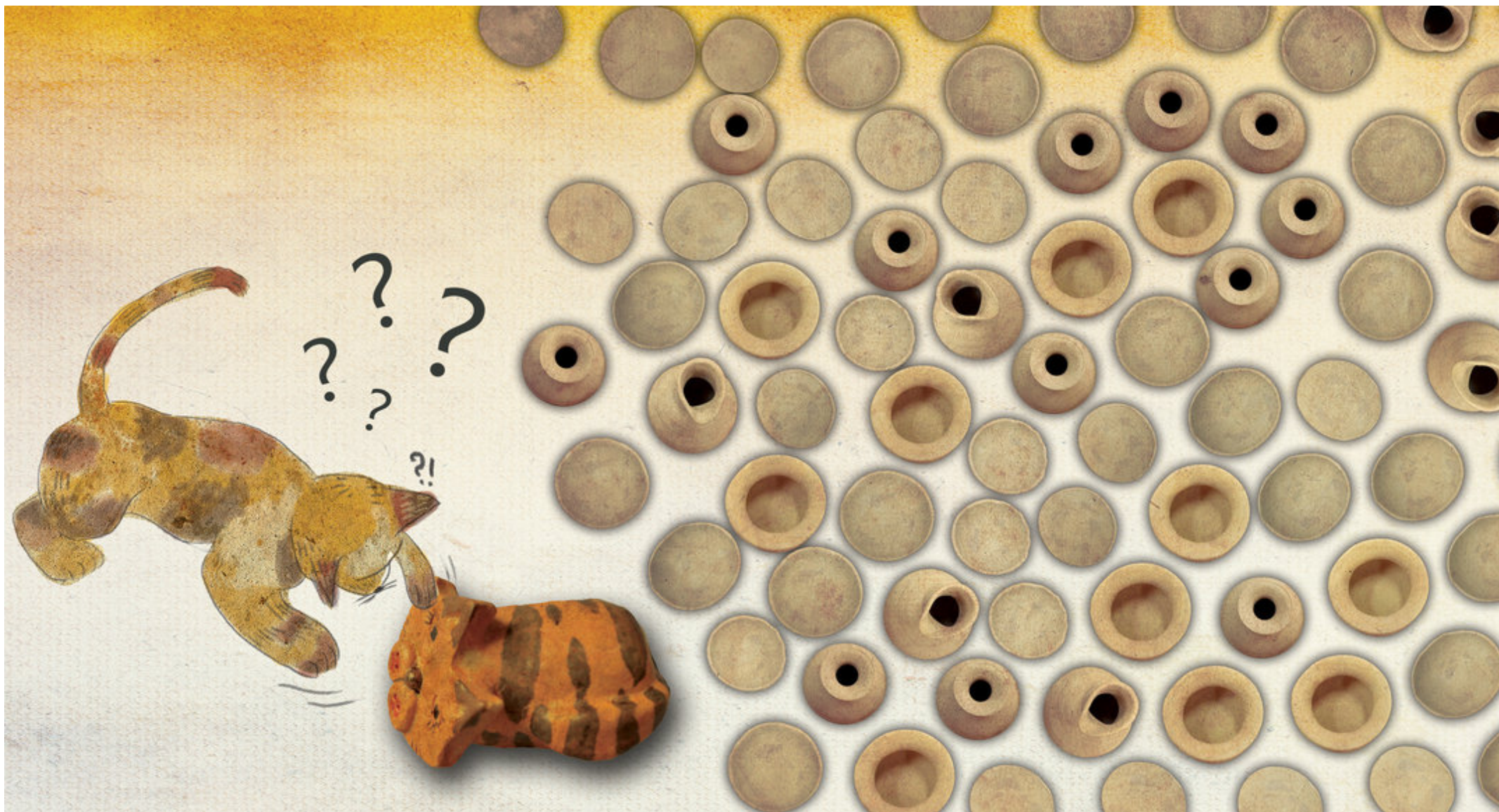

Person.





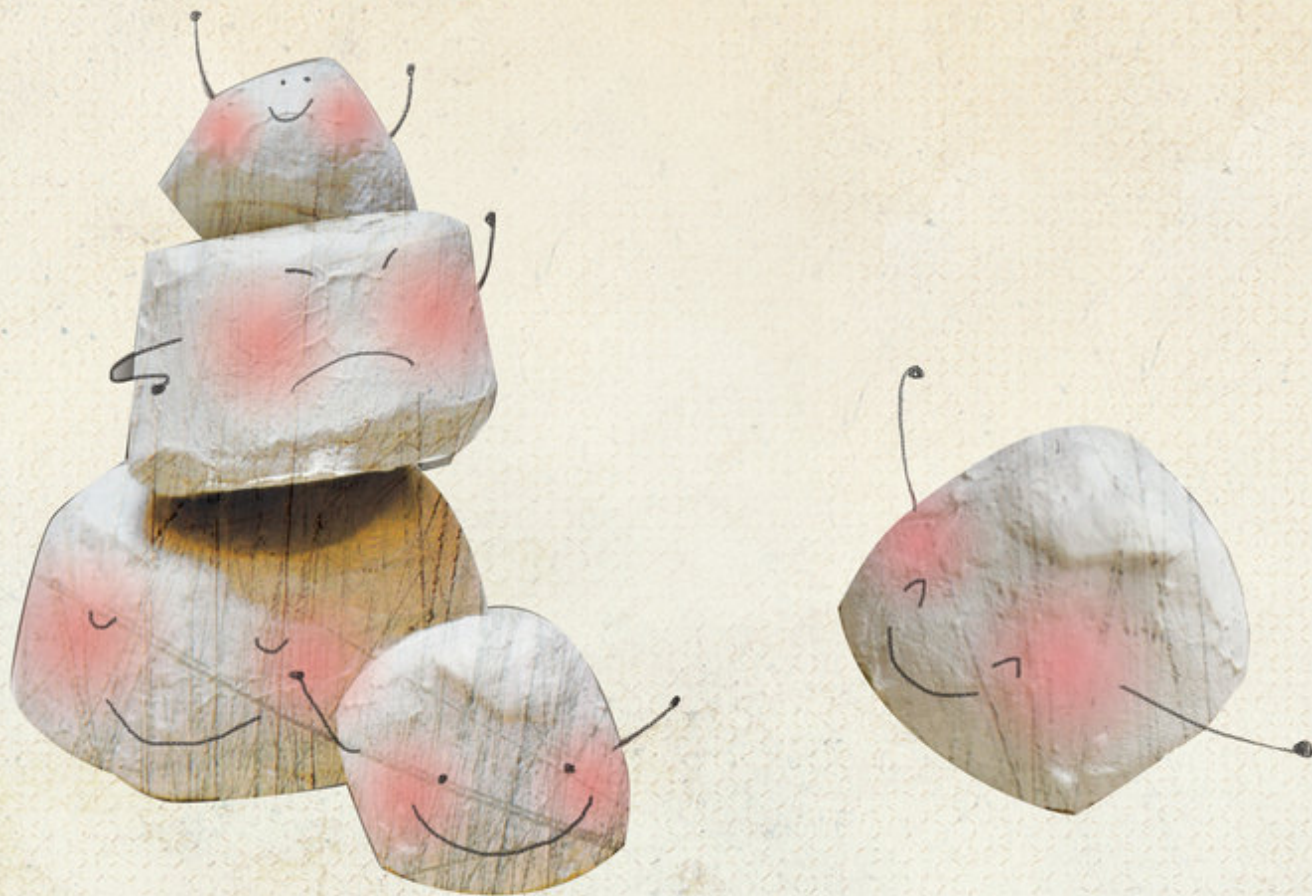
Pottery People can be seen everywhere!
