coming to buy his pies!

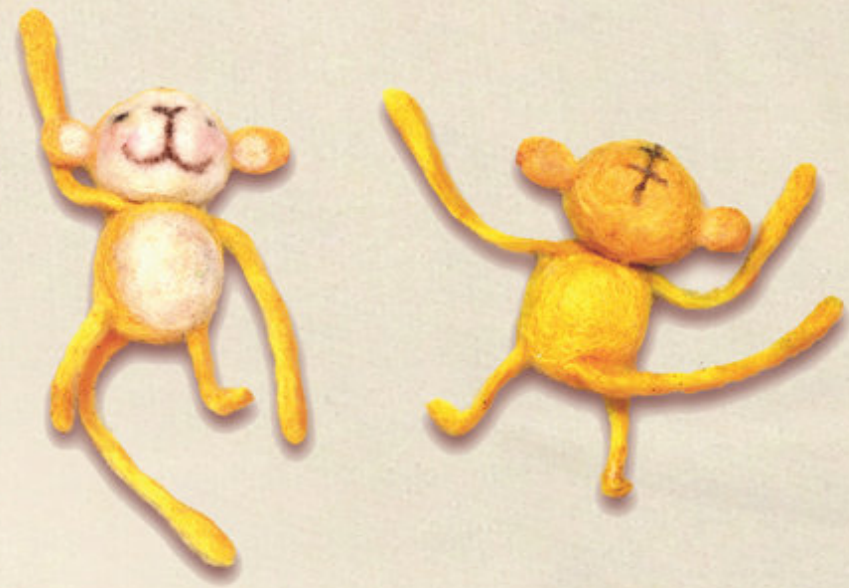
One has a big nose
and big ears.

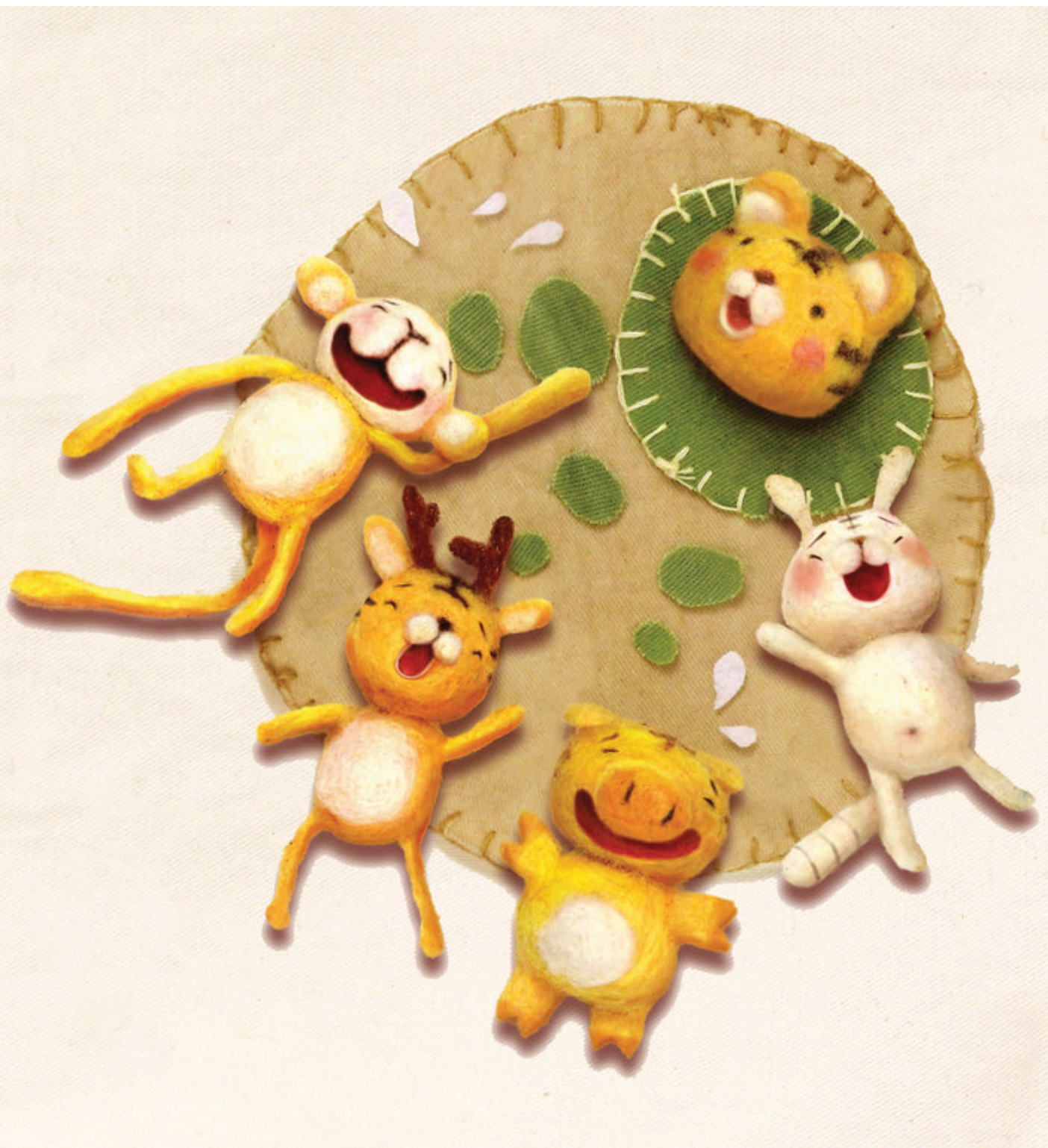


One has a pair
