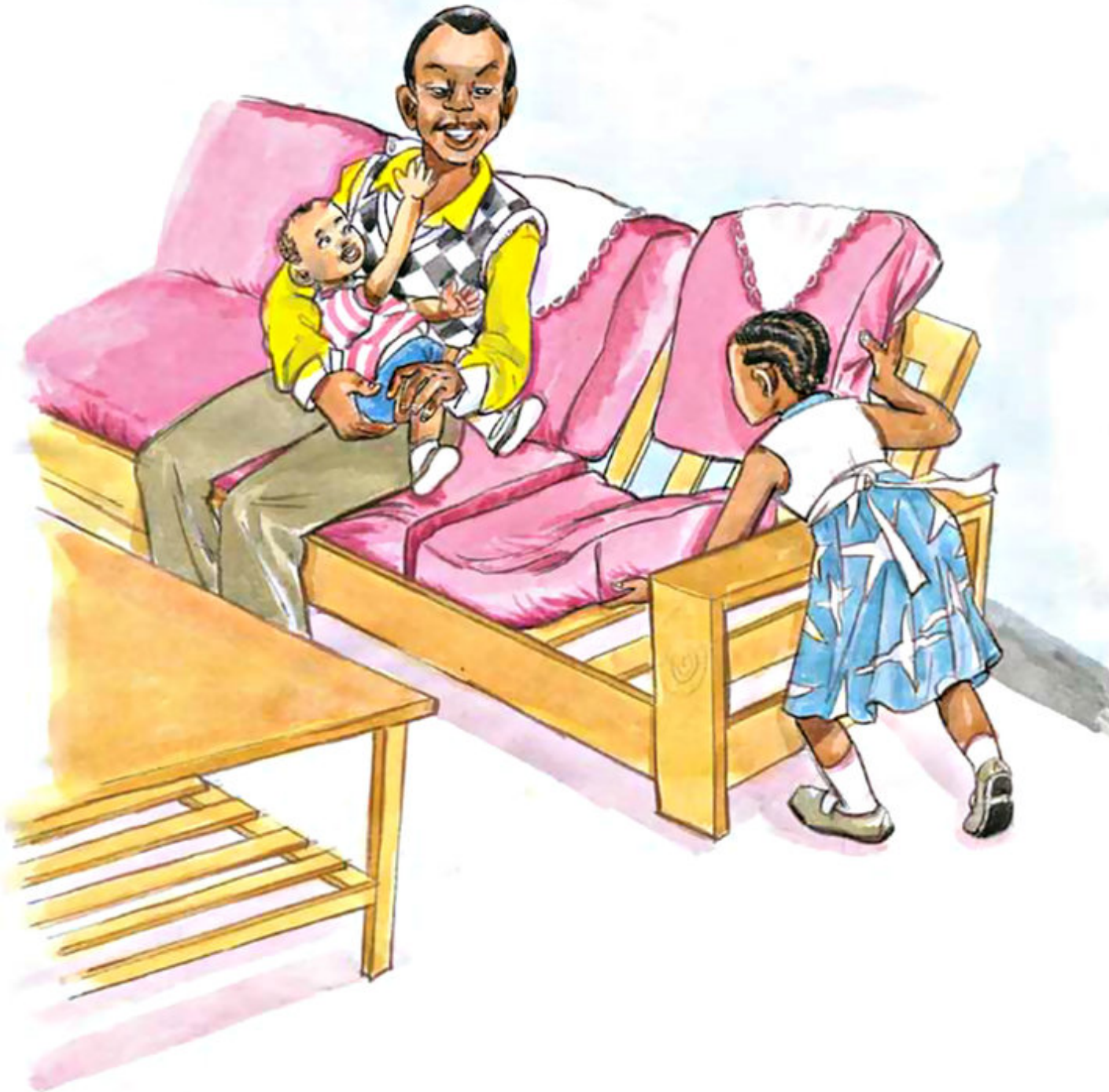

“What is it?” Dad asks.







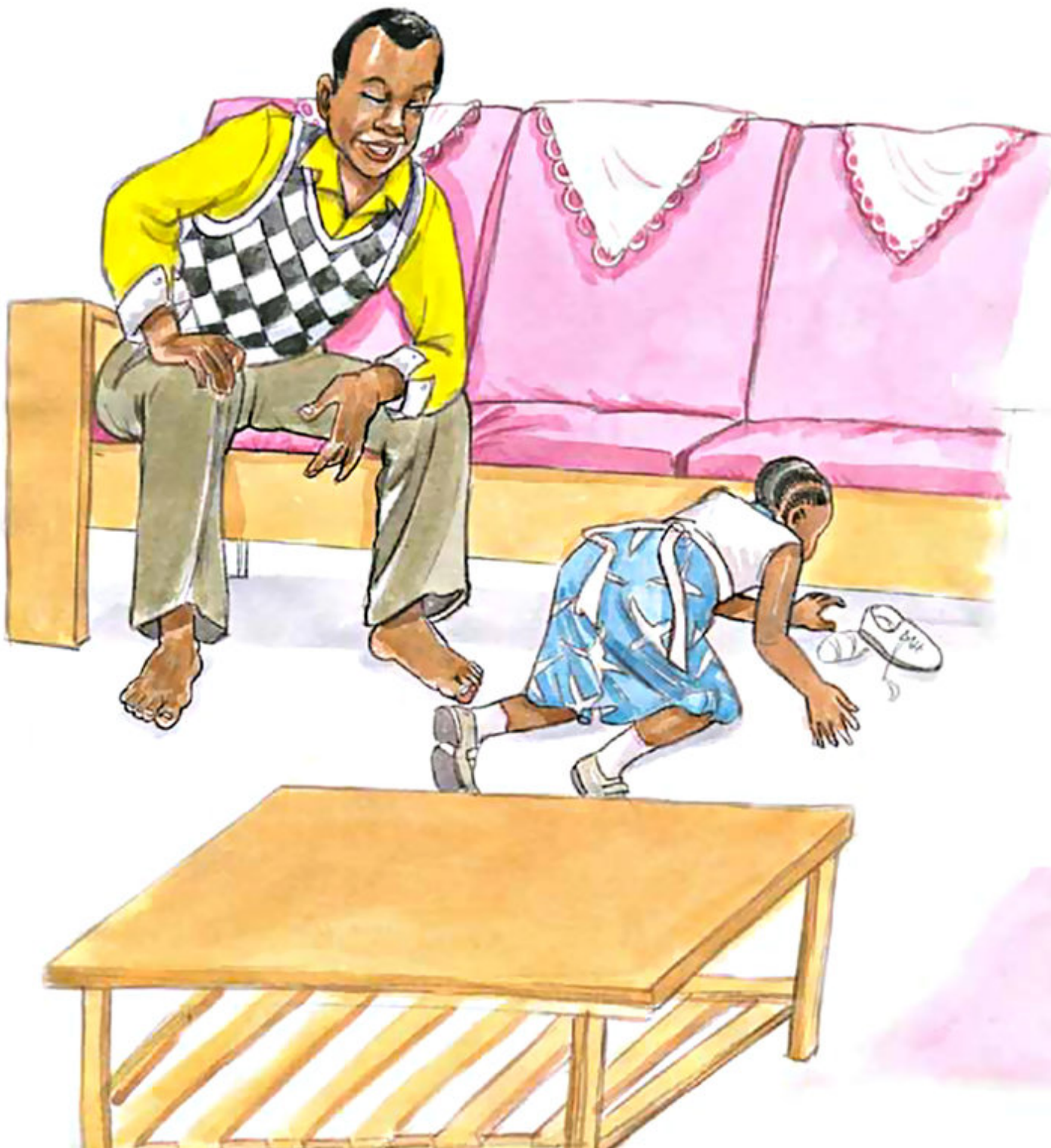
Bahati can't remember what she is looking for.

Dad tries to help her.

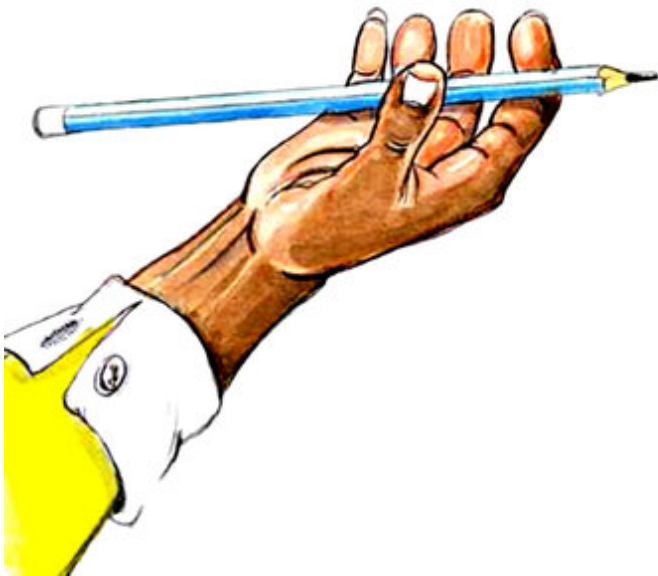
“Are you looking for this candy?” Dad asks.
