
"Hello, friends!" Douangkeo calls out. Their names are Duoangta, Khamla and Khonesavan.

As for Douangkeo, she wants to be a magician because she loves magic shows!




But she doesn't know what to do! She doesn't have the tools that a magician needs.

And her trusty dog will help.






First, Douangkeo turns the rice basket into a magic hat.
