grandmother told me.



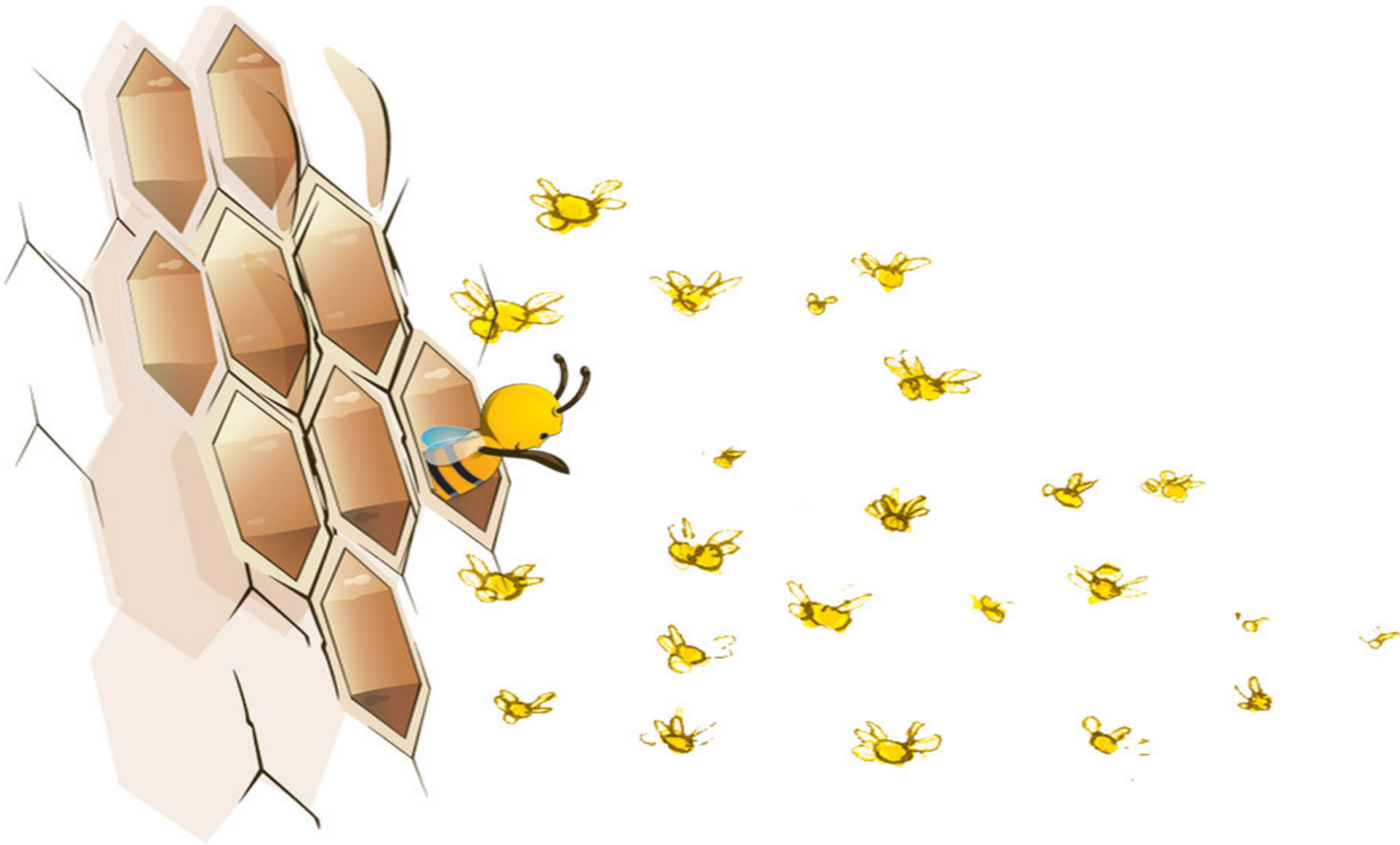
She said that bees are scared of smoke.
