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Look at the soil, my friend. The grass is so green here!



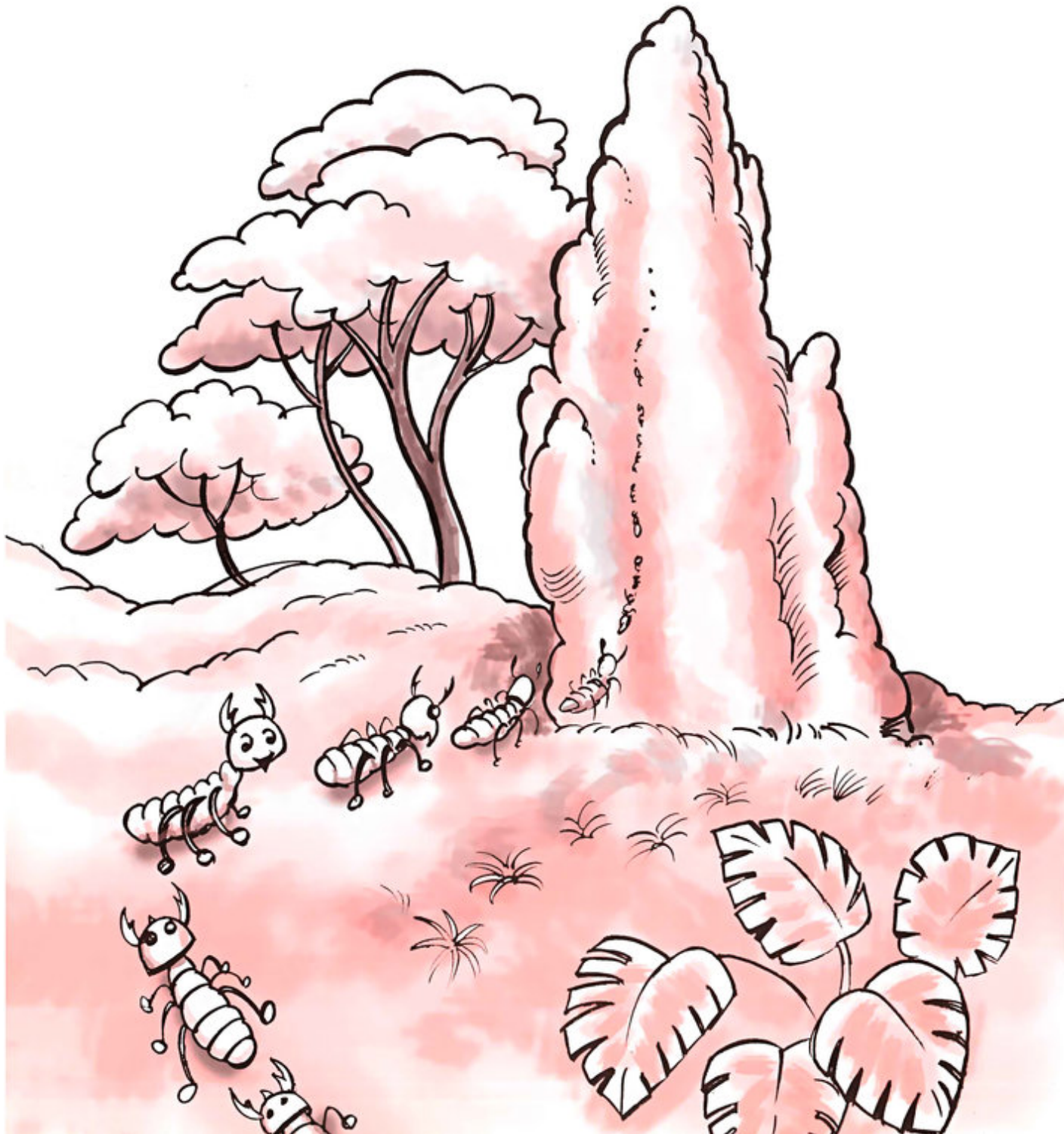
This is where

and wheat grow.

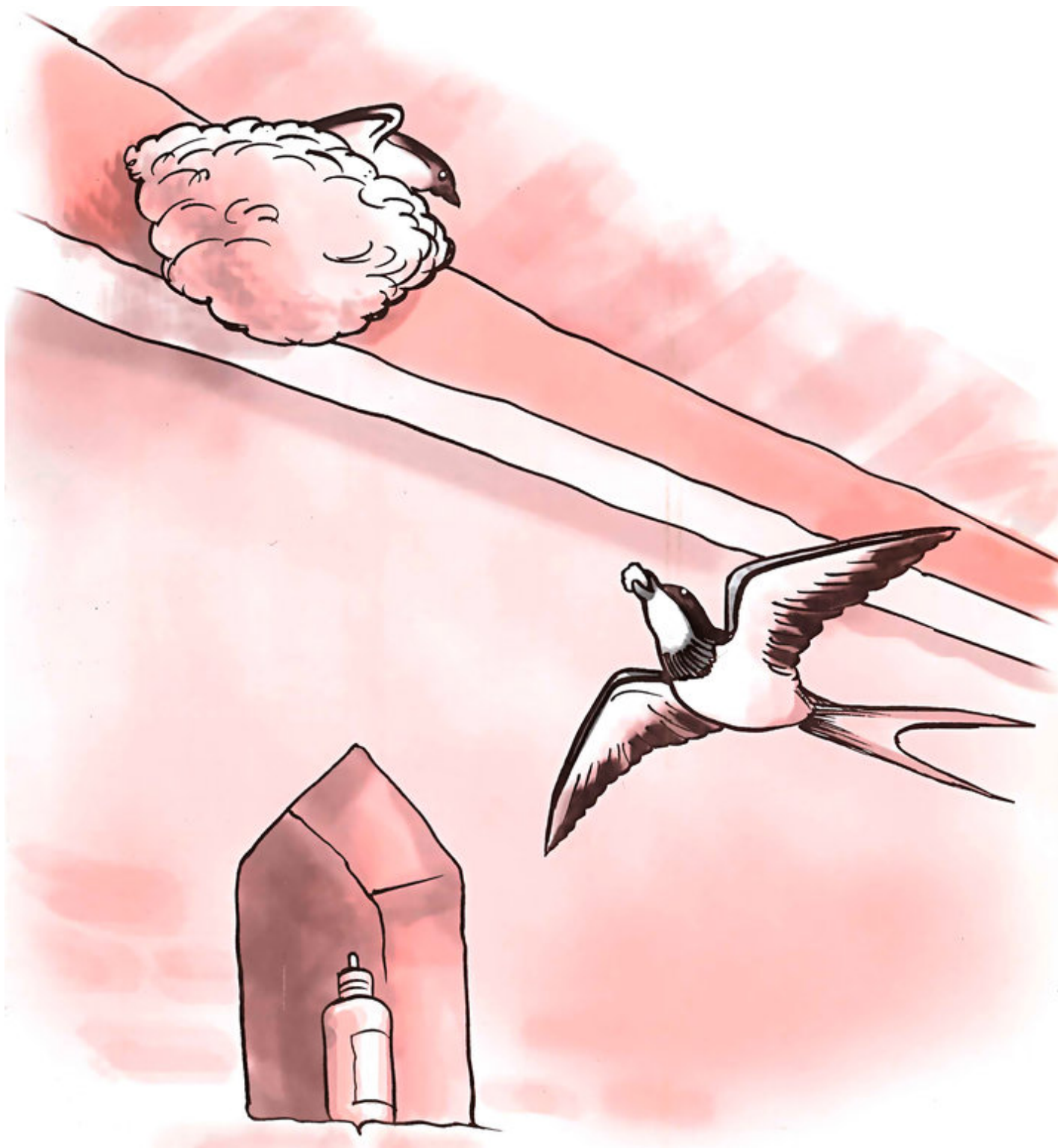


This is where the

The soil is where the mud dauber builds its nest.

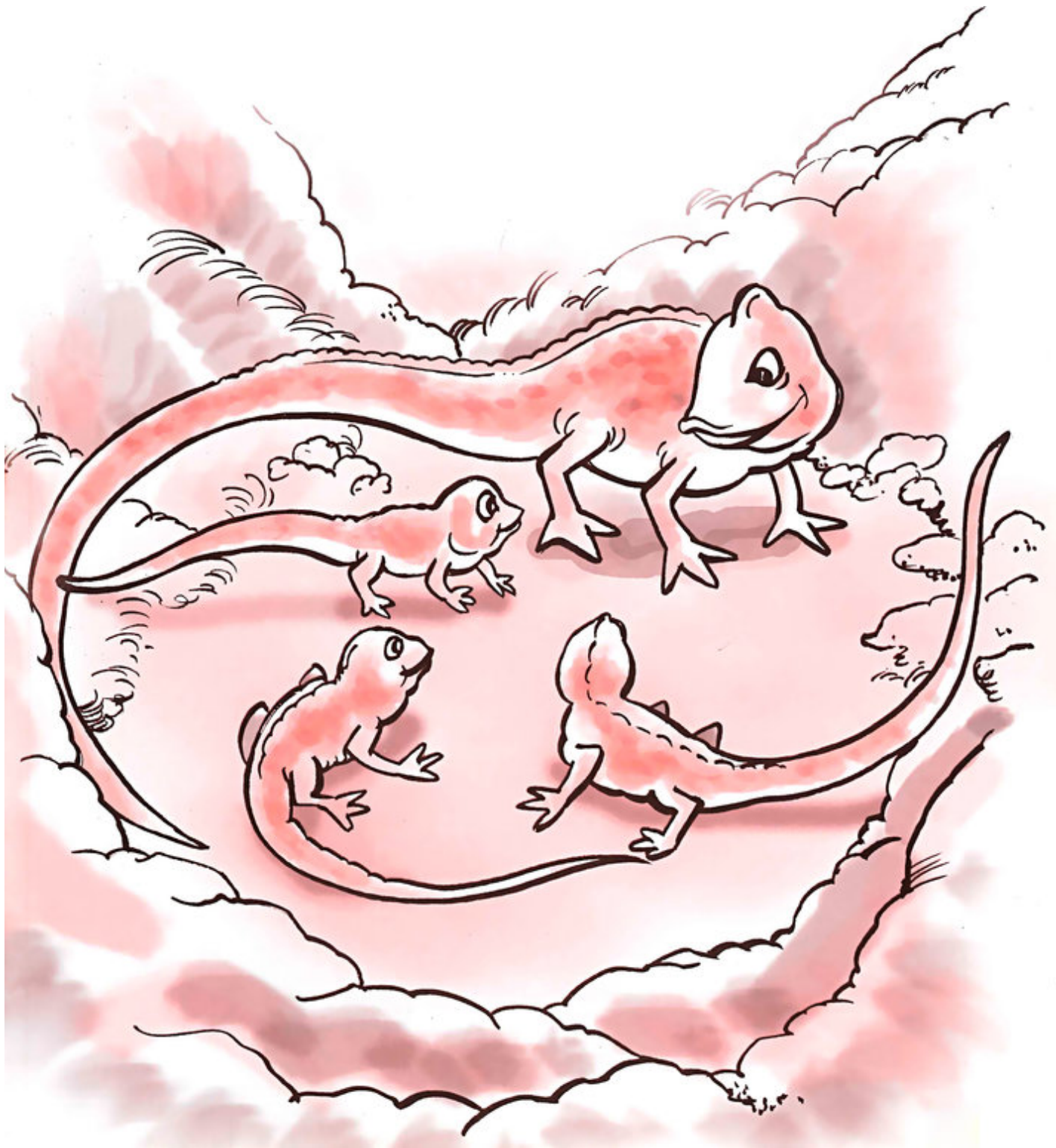
A mud dauber is a type of wasp that makes nests out of mud.
